**WaveRider – AmenityCard** is designed exclusively for properties that require the highest level of flexibility for their residents.

Some properties need the **convenience** and **modernity** of credit card payments, right at the laundry machine.

Some properties need the **simplicity** of offering an inclusive-laundry option as a resident amenity.

Now they can have both, at the same time.

By adding the new WavePoint AmenityCard, any standard WaveRider (credit card) property can also accept our new AmenityCard for laundry cycles.

Some residents and staff may be entitled to a specified number of cycles per month. Some could be issued a card with a limited amount of cycles as a bonus for renewing their lease. Perhaps the on-site Superintendent needs the ability to start machines as often as they deem necessary, without any value being charged.

All are possible – right from your web browser. Login to WaveCentral, enable the option, assign the cards, then hand them out.

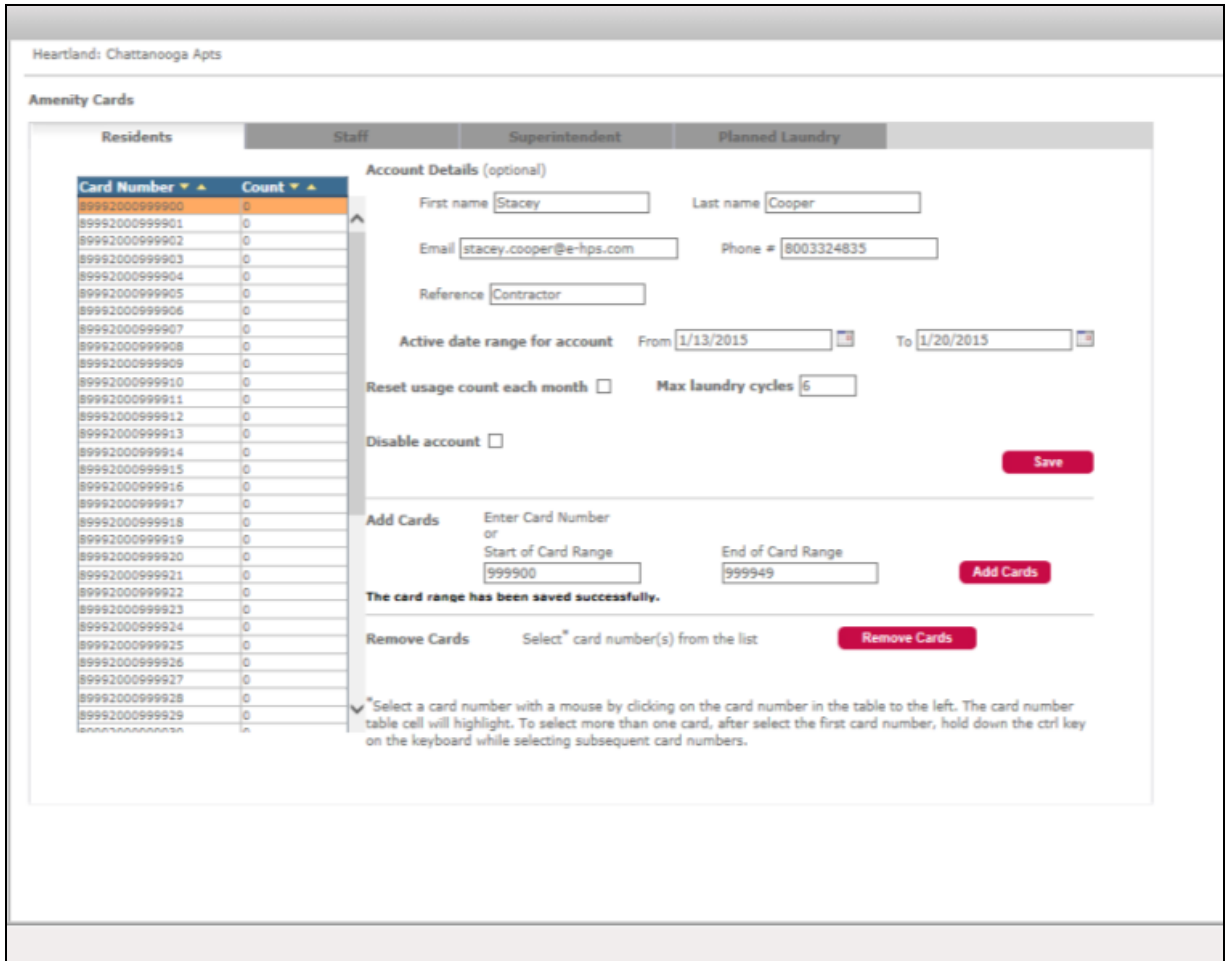

- 1 The Laundry Services Operator assigns specific AmenityCards to a property, and defines the way they will behave.
- 2 Residents that are eligible to receive an AmenityCard obtain it from property management.
- 3 Residents use their AmenityCard to start their laundry cycles. Residents that wish to pay for their cycles with credit & debit cards are free to do so.
